International sanctions in force in the Virgin Islands are the same as those in force in the UK.

## **Financial Sanctions Notice**

### 28 February 2025

# Russia

- 1. The **Foreign, Commonwealth and Development Office (FCDO**) has issued the following Financial Sanctions Notice. Please click <u>here</u> to access the link to the notice.

### What you must do in relation to this Financial Sanctions Notice

- 3. You must:
  - i. check whether you maintain frozen assets (i.e. accounts, funds, economic resources) of any person or entity that was previously on the consolidation list and subject to an asset freeze;
  - ii. Remove the person or entity from your institution's list of persons or entities subject to financial sanction;
  - iii. Un-freeze the assets of the person or entity and where necessary, re-activate all relevant accounts;
  - iv. Send advice to person or entity that the assets are no longer subject to an asset freeze; and
  - v. If you have previously frozen the assets of a person or entity that was subject to financial sanctions, you should report to the Virgin Islands Sanctions Unit the details of any actions taken in respect of the person or entity that is no longer subject to an asset freeze. Such actions should verify that:
    - a) The assets are no longer frozen
    - b) Where applicable, all relevant accounts have been re-activated; and
    - c) The entity or person has been removed from the institution's list of persons subject to financial sanctions
- 4. Failure to comply with financial sanctions legislation or to seek to circumvent its provisions is a criminal offence.
